In about 1939 the name was changed to the "Hohokam Museums Association" (HMA) (Arizona State Museum Archives, Hohokam Museum Association). Primarily from Arizona Historical Society, Tucson (AHS), MS 200, Folder 108, Cummings Collection, Arizona Historical Society, Tucson, and Arizona State Museum Archives, University of Arizona, Tucson. In August 2018, Alan Ferg discovered in the ASM Archives membership lists for 1942, 1943, and 1944 that clearly are for the HMA; he emailed them to DRW. These data are noted in the tables in the comments section with designations like, "Paid dues in 1944," etc.
